## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- You only need one library card. If you have multiple cards from member libraries, please select your home library and work with your librarians there to merge your accounts into one.
- Please be sure your home library has your email and telephone numbers in your record so that they may notify you when your requested materials become available.
- When you borrow from another library, circulation periods and fines may be different from those of your library.
- Please be sure you know when your materials are due.
- Depending upon transportation schedules, items may take up to fifteen days to arrive, although most will arrive much sooner. Please allow plenty of time, and don't set an expiration date that will occur before the material has a chance to travel to you.

## HOW TO PLACE A HOLD

One of the benefits of this partnership is the ability to borrow physical materials from any of the member libraries and have them delivered to your library. Below are the instructions for borrowing materials using the "Place Hold" function.

1. Start with your home library's online catalog. You may do this either from the library or anywhere you have an internet connection.
2. Login to your Library Account.
3. Search for the title you would like to borrow.
4. Choose the "Place Hold" option.
5. Choose your pick up location.
6. Set the expiration date.
7. Click "Place Hold."

You will be notified via email or phone when your item is available for checkout.

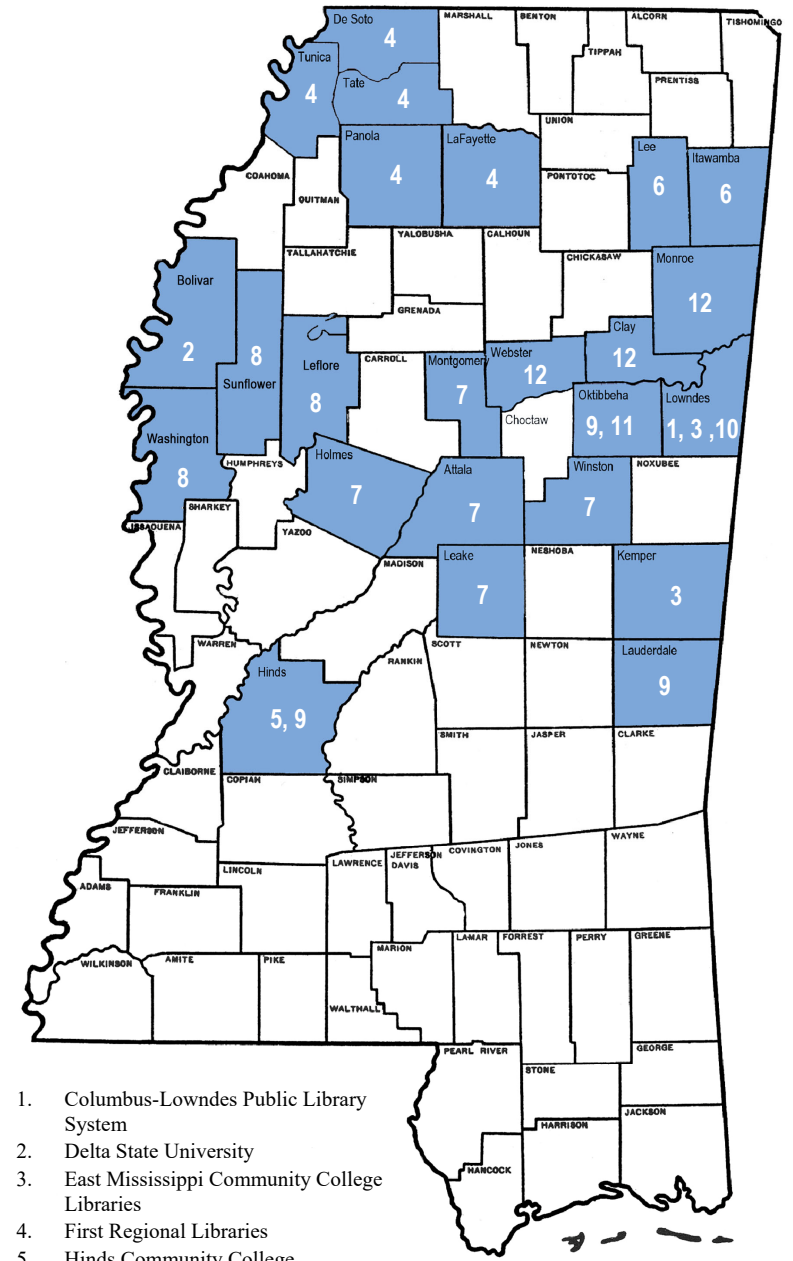
