Baker, Walter	1863, 1958. Civil War diary of Baker, who was wounded at Vicksburg; letter from Sallie Dodson to Baker; letters (2) concerning the diary and Dodson letter (1958).
Bracher, Katherine O. (2 folders)	1928. Correspondence, clippings, theater programs, postcards, other, concerning her trip to the United Kingdom, where she attended a summer institute in Cambridge.
Bracher, Katherine O., Writing Case	[1928.] Blank stationery of a shipping line and hotels in the United Kingdom, apparently collected during her trip.
Calhoun, W. H. Leather Wallet	1835. Wallet marked with the words "W. H. Calhoun, 1835"
Miscellaneous	1861-1958. Cotton receipts, letters, race course ticket (1878), World War I war savings stamps, genealogical information about the Fant family, wills of Andrew and Cornelius Carpenter (typed copies), clippings. Among the letters are a V-mail letter, a letter concerning the Vardaman-Percy campaign (1910), and accounts of Civil War battles, written in 1913-1925.
