Scope and Contents

The collection contains minutes, bylaws, memoranda, reports, grant proposals, and printed matter concerning the Board of Directors of the Child Development Group of Mississippi (CDGM) and its successor organization, the Inter-Area Council of the Community Education Extension of Mary Holmes College. The organizations administered Head Start programs that were funded by the U. S. Office of Economic Opportunity.

Dr. Lee Reiff, a professor at Millsaps College, was appointed to the CDGM Board in December 1966 and served until his resignation in December 1970. The collection consists of his files during his tenure as a board member.
